And when Jesus was transfigured before his disciples his clothes became dazzling white.

Why such pictures, but to say that God's outward glory is something more brilliant than light, more piercing than a trumpet blast, and more awe-inspiring than a thunderstorm. In this series we explore the glory and majesty of the God we worship. His glory in creation, his glory beheld by his people, his glory in his Son, and how we can be personally transformed from one degree of glory to another. May we see our glorious Lord in a new and dazzling light!



The opening of John's Gospel paints Jesus as God's Unique Son, Christ and Saviour. In the lead up to Christmas this year we explore more about who he is in all the Scriptures and more importantly who he is to us as we remember him as Emmanuel, God with us.




sundays at the ascension
